Aims/Objectives

The aims of the captioned programme are to enhance secondary school students' understanding of our natural environment and ecological footprint, as well as its interaction with social and economic development.

Details

2. As agreed in the 2002 Johannesburg Earth Summit, 2005 was set as the year to launch the programme entitled United Nations Decade of Education for Sustainable Development (SD). The objective is to promote the concept of SD through education, which is one of the important strategies to combat environmental, social and economic problems in the 21st Century. It is hoped that through international efforts and education, the aim to enhance a better living quality, resources conservation and global economic development can be achieved.
