Establishment of Waterbirds Conservation Stewardship through School and Community-based Education and Interpretation Project Summary : February 2009

A one-year local community-based project will be carried out by the Administration Bureau of Tumuji National Nature Reserve of Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region, People Republic of China. The Nature Reserve is an Important Bird Area (IBA) supporting over 300 species of birds, including 6 species of Cranes. A series of education and public awareness activities such as, training workshop, summer camp and “Love Birds Week”, will be carried out and expected to engage over 400 people from local school and village to understanding of waterbird conservation.
