## Migratory Waterbird Conservation and its Habitat in Deli Serdang District Sumatra Utara Province – Phase I Project Summary : April 2011

In order to collect data and information regarding the existence of shorebird migration in the Deli Serdang District, the Sumatra Rainforest Institute (SRI) will carry out intensive 12-month waterbirds monitoring programme together with local student volunteers. Monitoring results will be concluded in a workshop at the end of the project, which will inform local government and NGOs on the importance of the site and the needs for further protection. The project will also propose the Deli Serdang District to be nominated as an East Asian-Australasian Flyway (EAAF) network site.
